Pillar 7: Power

Just a Thought:

God saved us and we have established a relationship with Him. However, many of us have allowed the gifts that He has given us (job, kids, wife, things, etc.) to take a higher place in our lives than our relationship with God. For God's power to be evident in our lives, He must have the first place. Our families, ministries and jobs must take a back seat to our personal relationship with God.

Scripture:

"... My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong." 2 Corinthians 12:9-10
